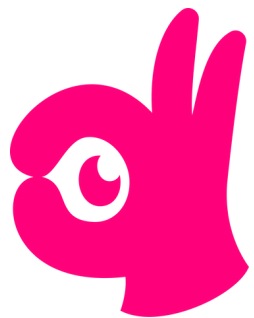
# **This is a unique opportunity to shape the future of social care recruitment**

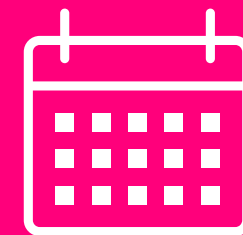
